#### Grounds Update

I hope that everyone had a great Thanksgiving and was able to spend it with family and friends. We have been very busy in the maintenance department continuing to clean up the damage from Hurricane Ian.

The tree contractor we use was able to get out the last week of November and helped us out with some of the bigger trees that we lost during the storm. We will continue to clean up some of the smaller trees that were damaged and then will start to work on removing the stumps.

The overseed was applied to the course the week of Thanksgiving and the seed is germinating very well. We have not had any rain since we applied the seed but are hoping to receive some over the next couple of weeks. During the establishment of the seed, we have been relying on the irrigation system to get the seed to germinate. This has resulted in some wet areas around the course. Once we get the seed established and start to mow it regularly, we will be able to cut back on the amount of irrigation. During the establishment period, we are asking you to please avoid the wet areas around the low areas of the course. If you see tracks going through an area, please do not follow them, but find another way around. The cooler weather that we had after the seed was applied helped with getting the seed off to a great start. We will start to mow the fairways and tees during the week of December 12th.

We have already started mowing the rough areas that were seeded and they are mowing out very well. Fertilizer will be applied to the course the week before Christmas to give the ryegrass some food to help it along during establishment. We are planning on being back to a normal mowing schedule by the first of the year. The golf course has been improving year over year and we ask you to please help us in the improvements by remembering to fix ball marks on the greens, filling divots, and abiding by the directional cart signs around the greens.



# Rosé Paloma Cocktail Recipe

- 2 ounces mezcal
- 4 ounces grapefruit soda
- 1 ounce rosé
- 1 ounce lime juice (freshly squeezed)
- 2-3 sprigs thyme
- worm salt
- grapefruit wedges
- Cut a lime wedge to wet the rim of your cocktail glass. Then, dip the rim into a bowl of worm salt.
- In a shaker, pour in mezcal, rosé, and lime juice.
- Shake for 10 seconds.
- Pour into a salt-rimmed and ice-filled cocktail glass.
- Top off with grapefruit soda.
- Garnish with a slice of grapefruit and a couple sprigs of thyme.
- First things first, cut a lime wedge to wet the rim of your cocktail glass. Then, dip the rim into a bowl of worm salt. Set the glass aside as you prepare the drink.
- Now for the fun part! In a shaker, pour in two ounces of mezcal, one ounce of rosé, and one ounce of freshly squeezed lime juice. Shake the mixture for 10 seconds, and pour into a salt-rimmed and ice-filled cocktail glass. Top the glass off with grapefruit soda, and garnish with a slice of grapefruit and a couple sprigs of thyme.

# Garlie Parmesan Baked Eggplant

- 1 large eggplant
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter melted
- 1 cup breadcrumbs
- 1/4 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 teaspoon smoked paprika
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon Italian seasoning

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- Start by preparing the eggplant: wash the eggplant and trim off the green end. You can peel the skin if you like. Next, slice eggplant into 1/2" disks. Place all disks in a colander or cooling rack set over a baking sheet, sprinkle with salt, and let sit for at least 30 minutes
- Next, melt butter in a bowl. Mix breadcrumbs, spices, and Parmesan cheese in another bowl.
- Dip each eggplant disk into butter first, then breading mixture. Place on aluminum foil or parchment paper lined baking sheet.
- Bake in 400 degrees F oven for 15 minutes, then flip each disk and baked for 7 more minutes. The eggplant should be golden brown and the breading crispy.
- Serve as a side dish, appetizer or use in eggplant Parmesan.

#### NOTES

Eggplant skin is completely edible. It's a personal preference, just like zucchini. You can peel the skin off or leave it.
