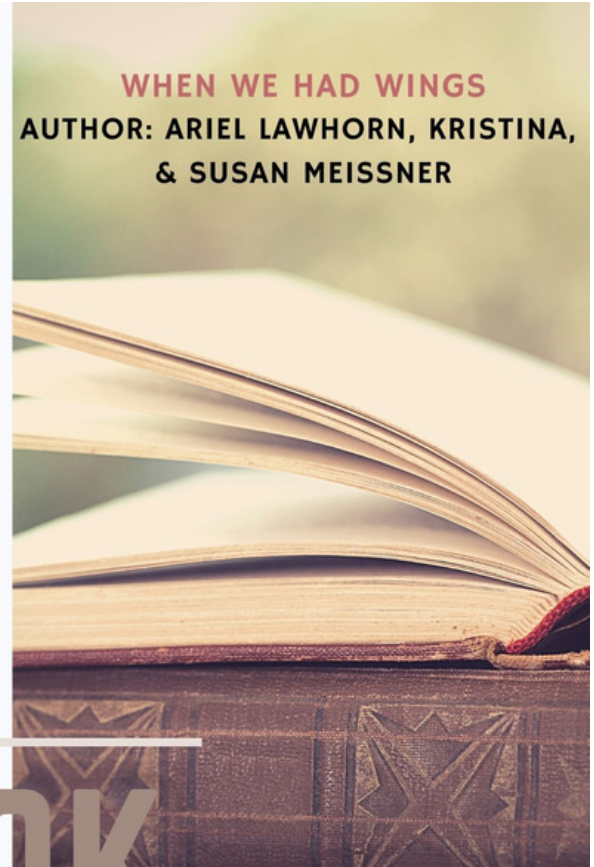

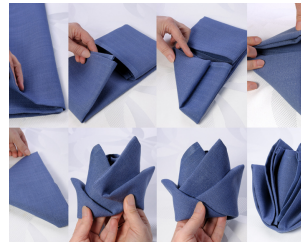

TWIN ISLES LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION (TILGA)

TILGA is the 18-hole and 9-hole Ladies Golf Group which is open to all TICC Women Golf Members. TILGA plays year-round on Wednesday mornings at TICC. The 18-hole tee times typically begin at 9 AM and the 9-hole play starts after the 18-holers have teed off. Golfers of all levels are welcome. The Games and Tournament schedule is posted on the Pro Shop bulletin board and the weekly sign-up sheet is also posted there. (Remember to sign up at least 48 hours in advance!) The Golf Pro assigns tee times for those who have signed up.

Annual dues are \$35. There is also a weekly event fee of \$5, with higher fees for some tournaments. The TILGA year runs from May 2023 through April 2024. We are currently in the summer schedule which runs through October 4, 2023.

The first day of play for the regular season is October 11, 2023. We will have our opening day scramble and luncheon two weeks later on October 25. There will be a variety of games and tournaments throughout the year, along with a holiday scramble and luncheon, Member-Member tournament, Member-Guest tournament, Skirts and Shirts, and Gals and Pals. The Closing Day luncheon will be on April 17, 2024.

If you are interested in joining TILGA, talk to any of the members, or contact one of the officers listed below. Being a part of TILGA is a great way to meet many TICC women golfers, play golf each week, improve your game, and maybe win some prizes!

The Cherry Cruise by Barbara Jenkins

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 ½ oz. of Citrus Vodka
- 1 oz. Triple Sec
- 1 oz. Cherry Brandy
- 2 oz. Sour Mix
- Splash of Grenadine
- Lemon & Cherry for Garnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Pour all ingredients into a shaker.
2. SHAKE WELL.
3. In a glass put a splash of grenadine and ice on top
4. Pour mixture into a glass.
5. Garnish with Lemon & Cherry! ENJOY!



Blueberry Whiskey Buck

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Lemon
- 2 tsp. organic sugar
- 15 fresh blueberries
- 2 oz. Whiskey of your choice
- 1-2 oz. Ginger beer
- Mint

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. In a cocktail shaker, muddle 1 lemon wedge & sugar.
2. Add blueberries and muddle until all the blueberries are crushed.
3. Pour in the Whiskey, cover, and shake vigorously.
4. Fill the rock's glass with ice.
5. Strain the cocktail over ice.
6. Top with ginger beer and garnish with mint, lemon, and blueberries

Crockpot Blueberry Crisp



INGREDIENTS:

- 4 cups fresh blueberries
- 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup regular oats (not instant)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup light brown sugar
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup white whole wheat flour (you can also use all-purpose)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cinnamon
- pinch of nutmeg
- pinch of salt
- 4 tablespoons butter, room temperature

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Spray the inside of a 6-quart crock pot with cooking spray.
- Layer the blueberries on the bottom of the crock pot.
- Stir in sugar, lemon zest, and lemon juice; set aside.
- In a mixing bowl, combine oats, light brown sugar, flour, cinnamon, nutmeg, and salt.
- Add the butter and cut it in with two knives or a pastry blender; cut and blend until the mixture is crumbly.
- Sprinkle the oat mixture over the blueberries.
- Cover and cook on HIGH for 1 hour and 30 minutes, on LOW for 2 hours and 30 minutes.
- Remove the cover and continue to cook for 30 more minutes.
- Serve.



Breakfast Taquitos

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 teaspoon vegetable oil, plus more for brushing
- 6 ounces breakfast sausage, casings removed.
- 5 large eggs, beaten.
- Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
- 4 ounces cheddar, shredded (1 cup)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup homemade or store-bought salsa
- 6 flour tortillas (each 8 inches)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 425°F. Heat oil and sausage in a medium nonstick skillet over medium-high; cook, breaking up meat into bite-size pieces with the back of a spoon, until cooked through, 5 to 6 minutes.
2. Add eggs, season with salt and pepper. Cook, stirring, until soft curds form, 30 seconds. Remove from heat; stir in cheese and salsa. Divide mixture among tortillas (about $\frac{1}{3}$ cup each); roll up and place, seam-side down, on a baking sheet.
3. Brush taquitos with oil and bake until shells are crisp, and cheese is melted 12 to 14 minutes.

Cook's Notes

Once baked, the taquitos can be wrapped tightly in plastic and frozen for up to two months. Reheat on a baking sheet in a preheated 375°F oven until crisp and warmed through about 20 minutes.
