

Lavender Lemonade

INGREDIENTS

- 1 ½ oz. Empress 1908 Gin
- 1 oz Limoncello
- 1 oz lavender simple syrup (see recipe below)
- 1 ½ oz lemonade
- splash of tonic water

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.Fill a cocktail shaker with ice. Add the gin, limoncello, simple syrup and lemonade then shake for 30 seconds.
- 2.Fill an 8 0z. glass with ice. Pour cocktail over ice and top with tonic.
- 3.Stir and garnish with a lemon wedge dipped in organic lavender flowers, or other edible flowers of your choice
- 4.Rim glass with purple sugar, which is made by dropping 2 drops of purple food gel into a ½ C sugar and mix for 2 minutes until well combined.

Lavendar Simple Syrup:

Mix ½ cup sugar and 1 cup water in a sauce pan along over medium heat for 3-4 minutes (until sugar has dissolved and liquid has reduced by ¼). Remove from heat and drop 1 tablespoon organic lavender flowers into the mixture. Allow mixture to cool in refrigerator for 30 minutes. You can either strain the flowers from the mixture or they can be incorporated into the drink.



April Showers

INGREDIENTS:

- 3 ounces (88 ml) gin
- 1 ounce fresh (30 ml) lemon juice
- 11/2 tablespoons agave nectar
- 6 ounces (180 ml) ruby red grapefruit juice
- Edible flowers for garnish, optional

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Fill a cocktail shaker with ice. Add the gin, lemon juice, agave nectar and grapefruit juice, shake vigorously for 10 seconds.
- 2. Pour into a coupe or martini glass.
- 3. Garnish with edible flowers (optional)









Carrot Cake Smoothie

INGREDIENTS:

- Oat Milk (or other non-dairy milk)
- 1 teaspoon Vanilla Extract
- 1 Banana (frozen)
- ½ cup Pineapple Chunks (frozen diced) 1 cup Carrot (shredded)
- ⅓ cup Greek Yogurt
- 1 tablespoon Almond Butter
- ½ teaspoon Ground Cinnamon
- add pinch Ground Ginger
- add pinch Ground Nutmeg

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.Add the oat milk and vanilla extract to the base of your blender.
- 2.Next, add the frozen banana, frozen pineapple, shredded carrot,
- Greek yogurt, almond butter, and spices.
- 3.Blend everything until smooth and creamy. Add a bit more oat milk if needed.



Brussel Sprout Crustini

INGREDIENTS:

- One pound bag of brussels sprouts and a little olive oil for sautéing.
- For the dressing: we're tossing those brussels in a delicious, light dressing made with olive oil, lemon juice & zest, pure maple syrup (or honey), Dijon mustard, garlic powder, and plenty of salt & pepper.
- For the crostini: you'll need either a French baguette or loaf of Italian bread, plus sharp white cheddar cheese, grated parmesan, and some chopped, roasted pistachios. For the hot honey: homemade hot honey is made just with honey
- and a little hot sauce or a pinch of cayenne pepper.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Prep your baking sheet. Start by lining 1-2 large baking sheets with parchment paper, and spread the baguette slices on top.
- 2. Shred the brussel sprouts. Next, shred your brussels sprouts using a food processor or a sharp knife.
- 3. Make the dressing. Mix together all of the ingredients for the dressing and set aside.
- 4. Cook the brussel sprouts. Cook your brussels with olive oil until they turn slightly golden and a little crispy. Be careful not to burn them. Then turn off the heat and toss them with the dressing.
- 5. Assemble the crostini. Evenly divide the brussels sprouts mixture over each slice of bread. Top with cheese and the chopped pistachios, and bake until slightly golden.
- 6.Drizzle & serve. Finally, mix together your hot honey and drizzle it over each crostini. Serve & enjoy!

Turandot is an opera in three acts by Giacomo Puccini to a libretto in Italian by Giuseppe Adami and Renato Simoni. Puccini left the opera unfinished at the time of his death in 1924; it premiered in 1926 after the music was posthumously completed by Franco Alfano.

The opera is set in China and follows the Prince Calaf, who falls in love with the cold Princess Turandot. In order to win her hand in marriage, a suitor must solve three riddles, with a wrong answer resulting in their execution. Calaf passes the test, but Turandot refuses to marry him. He offers her a way out: if she is able to guess his name before dawn the next day, he will accept death.
