

COCKTAILS





Frozen June Bug

INGREDIENTS

- 2 c. Orange Sherbert
- 1 c. Sierra Mist
- 4 T. Grenadine
- 8-10 Ice Cubes
- Orange Slices & Cherries for Garnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Combine all ingredients in a blender. Blend until smooth.
- 2. Pour into glasses and garnish with an orange slice and a cherry.
- 3. Serve cold and enjoy!
- 4. This tasty summer mocktail is bursting with flavor—perfect as is, or just add your favorite spirit to turn it into a refreshingly boozy treat!



Martha Stewart's Yellow Watermelon Margaritas

INGREDIENTS

- 1/3 cup sugar
- Peeled zest of 2 limes, plus 1/3 cup fresh lime juice, plus lime wedges for making salt rim, plus thinly sliced rounds for serving (optional)
- ½ small seedless yellow watermelon (about 2½ pounds), peeled and cut into cubes (about 6 cups)
- 6 ounces tequila blanco
- 1 ounce elderflower liqueur, such as St. Germain
- Coarse salt or Himalayan pink salt, for glasses

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.Bring sugar, 1/3 cup water, and lime peels to a boil, stirring, until sugar has dissolved. Remove from heat; let cool completely. Strain into a pitcher with lime juice.
- 2. Working in batches, purée watermelon in a food processor or blender; strain through a coarse-mesh sieve (you should have 3 cups). Add melon purée, tequila, and elderflower liqueur to the pitcher with lime syrup and stir. Chill, covered, at least 2 hours and up to 2 days.
- 3. When ready to serve, run a lime wedge around the rim of each glass and dip glasses in coarse salt. Fill glasses with ice and 1 or 2 thin lime rounds. To make each drink, add more ice and 1/2 cup tequila mixture to a cocktail shaker. Shake 15 seconds; strain into a glass. Repeat for remaining drinks and serve immediately.

Lemon Sheet Cake

INGREDIENTS:

- oil
- ½ cup butter, softened
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 cup chopped pecans, save half for garnishing
- 1 (8) oz cream cheese
- 12 oz whipped topping
- 1 cup powdered sugar sifted
- lemon pudding
- 3 cups milk

OPTIONAL LEMON GLAZE:

- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2-3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- You can also garnish your lemon cake with fresh fruit to give a pop of color!

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F and oil or spray the 9x13-inch pan.
- 2.To make the crust, mix the butter and all-purpose flour in a large bowl; add the pecans. Add the crust to the pan, press down, and bake in the oven at 350°F for 15–20 minutes. Remove from the oven and allow to cool completely.
- 3.In another bowl, add the cream cheese, whipped topping, and powdered sugar, and mix. Set the bowl aside.
- 4.In another bowl, add the pudding and 3 cups of milk. Mix until it forms a custard.
- 5.To layer, first add the cream cheese mixture (not all of it, because you will need some later). Then add all the custard, and finish with the rest of the cream cheese mixture. Garnish with pecans.
- 6.Place in the freezer overnight if you would like a frozen treat, or in the refrigerator for a couple of hours until chilled. Serve immediately.

INGREDIENTS:

- For the Veggie & Brie Cup:
- 1/2 lb. Murray's Mini Brie
- 8 rainbow carrot spears
- 8 Persian cucumber spears
- 8 breakfast radish wedges
- 8 cherry tomatoes
- 8 Firehóok Multigrain Crackers

INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 lb. Alisios®
- 8 watermelon spears
- 8 orange slices
- 8 strawberries
- 32 blueberries

INGREDIENTS:

- For the S'mores & Blue Cup:
- 1/2 lb. Champignon Cambozola Black Label
- 1 ea. Vesta Milk Chocolate Covered Pretzel Gems, 180 g.
- 1 ea. Pralus Chocolatier Tablette Melissa bar, 100 g.
- 16 marshmallows
- 16 Effie's Homemade Oatcakes

INGREDIENTS:

- Other:
- 32 5-in. skewers
- 24 2-oz. cups

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. **PREP:** Cut the wheel of Mini Brie into ten equal wedges. You'll use 8 for the cups (the other two make a great chef's snack.) Slice the Alisios and Cambozola into eight 1-oz. triangles. Break the Pralus Melissa chocolate bar into eight planks that are four squares long. For the part of the bar that doesn't have squares, cut it in half lengthwise into two pieces the same size as the other planks.


