


# Interest Groups


Interest groups and social clubs create a great opportunity for members to learn a new skill, make new friends, or share a hobby with other members who have similar interests.












CROSSWORD PUZZLE

**©** Pro Tip of the Month: Master the Short Game Want to drop strokes fast? Focus on your chipping and putting. The short game is where the magic happens.

#### Here's a quick tip to get you started:

Use the "Y" Drill.

When setting up for a chip shot, picture your arms and club forming a solid "Y" shape. Keep that "Y" intact during your swing to avoid flipping your wrists. Consistent contact = better results!

#### **Bonus Tip:**

Practice with just one ball and treat each chip like it's the real deal on the course. Mimicking pressure situations helps build confidence when it counts.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 6-8 ice cubes
- 0.75 oz. Smirnoff Red, White, & Berry Seltzer
- 0.75 oz. Italian aperitif
- 0.75 oz. Sparkling water
- 1 thin orange slice for garnish
- Search Amazon for fun

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Fill a wine goblet with ice. Add Smirnoff Seltzer Red White and Berry, followed by Aperol and soda water. Garnish with an orange slice, mint and edible orange flower petals.

- 3. Add ice and shake.
- 4. Strain the contents into an ice-filled highball glass, while simultaneously pouring ginger beer.
- 5. Garnish with a fresh slice of ginger and smile.
