

Interest groups and social clubs create a great opportunity for members to learn a new skill, make new friends, or share a hobby with other members who have similar interests.



### Caribbean Cloud Sky

#### INGREDIENTS

- 2 oz Malibu Rum (coconut rum)
- 1c rainbow sherbert (lime, raspberry, orange flavors)
- 1/2c crushed ice (optional, for thicker slushy texture)
- Whipped Cream (for topping
- Blue Maraschino cherry (for garnish

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Combine sherbert, rum, and crushed ice in blender. Blend until smooth and creamy.
- Pour into chilled Hurricane glasses
- Top with whipped cream & cherry
- Serve immediately!





### Hummus Veggie Wrap

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 2 flavored wrap or tortilla, I used spinach
- 3/3 cup hummus, any flavor you like
- · 4 slices cucumber, thinly sliced lengthwise
- handful of fresh spinach leaves
- · 4 sliced small tomatoes
- ½ avocado, sliced
- alfalfa or broccoli sprouts
- · microgreens

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Spread the hummus on the bottom ½ of the wrap, about ½ inch from the bottom edge but spreading out the side edges.
- Layer the cucumber, spinach leaves, tomato slices, avocado slices, spouts, and microgreens.
- Fold the wrap tightly, as you would a burrito, tucking in all of the veggies with the first roll then rolling firmly to the end. Cut in half and enjoy.
