Interest groups and social clubs create a great opportunity for members to learn a new skill, make new friends, or share a hobby with other members who have similar interests.



Love Martini

Ingredients:

- $\frac{1}{4}$ ounce rum
- $\frac{1}{4}$ ounce peach schnapps
- $\frac{1}{4}$ ounce Vodka
- 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ounces cranberry juice
- 2 strawberries (garnish)
- 1 lime wedge (optional)
- Sugar for the glass rim

INSTRUCTIONS:

TO MAKE STRAWBERRY HEARTS FOR THE GARNISH, CUT A SMALL V TO REMOVE THE STEM OF THE STRAWBERRY. THEN, CUT THE STRAWBERRY INTO SLICES. RIM THE GLASS WITH SUGAR, IF DESIRED, BY WETTING THE RIM OF THE GLASS AND DIPPING IT INTO THE SUGAR.



Valentine Love Cake

INGREDIENTS

- 4 tablespoons (1/2 stick) butter, softened
Frosting / Icing
- 3/4 cups granulated sugar
- 1 cup confectioners' Sugar
- 2 Eggs
- 4 teaspoons milk
- 3 ounces bittersweet chocolate
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup buttercream frosting
- 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract, 4 oz.
- 1 oz. pink icing color
- 3/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 oz. green icing color
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 1 oz. sky blue icing color
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- Heart sprinkles
- 1/3 cup sour cream
- Fresh raspberries
- vegetable pan spray
- Edible flowers

INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 325°F. Prepare a heart-shaped fluted tube pan with vegetable pan spray.
- In a large bowl, beat butter and sugar with an electric mixer until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, mixing well in between each. Add chocolate and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla; mix well. Combine flour and salt; stir baking soda into sour cream. Alternately add sour cream and flour to the butter mixture, beating until just combined. Pour batter into prepared pan.
- Bake 40-45 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean. Cool in the pan on a cooling rack for 15 minutes. Remove the cake from the pan and cool completely.
- Make and tint buttercream icing. Prepare buttercream icing and divide into three 1/4 cup portions. Tint portions light pink, dark pink, and green (combine Kelly Green with a little Sky Blue for green shown). Set icing aside.
- Make glaze. Combine confectioners' sugar, milk, and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract. Stir until smooth and pour over the top of the cake.
- Decorate the cake. Top the cake with raspberries and flowers, and support with dots of light pink icing. Pipe tip 16 and 18 stars in light pink, dark pink, and green icings on the cake top. Add sprinkles. Let dry 1 hour.

Yields 6 servings.
