


## Interest Groups

## Tequila Sunrise

### Ingredients:

- 2 ounces Blanco tequila
- 4 ounces orange juice, freshly squeezed
- 1/4-ounce grenadine
- Garnish: orange slice
- Garnish: cherry

### INSTRUCTIONS:

ADD THE TEQUILA AND THEN THE ORANGE JUICE TO A CHILLED HIGHBALL GLASS FILLED WITH ICE. TOP WITH THE GRENADINE, WHICH WILL SINK TO THE BOTTOM OF THE GLASS, CREATING A LAYERED EFFECT. GARNISH WITH AN ORANGE SLICE AND A CHERRY.



### The Tequila Sunrise cocktail, did you know????

This classic drink has only three ingredients—tequila, grenadine, and orange juice—and is served unmixed to preserve the color of each layer.

The Tequila Sunrise was created in the early 1970s by Bobby Lozoff and Billy Rice at the Trident bar in Sausalito, California. The cocktail achieved notoriety after a member of the Rolling Stones—in some tellings it was Mick Jagger, while others have it as Keith Richards—tasted it at a party to kick off The Rolling Stones' 1972 tour. The band began ordering it at stops across the country, which helped to propel the drink's popularity.

In 1973, Jose Cuervo put the recipe on the back of its tequila bottles, and that same year, the Eagles released a song called "Tequila Sunrise" on their "Desperado" album. These infusions into popular culture resulted in the drink going mainstream, and it has been a part of the cocktail canon ever since.
