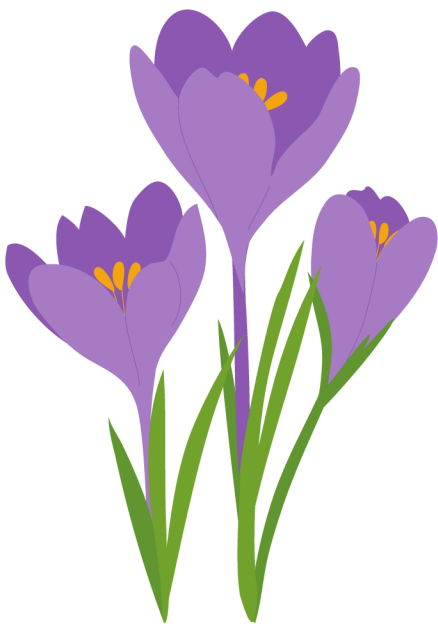

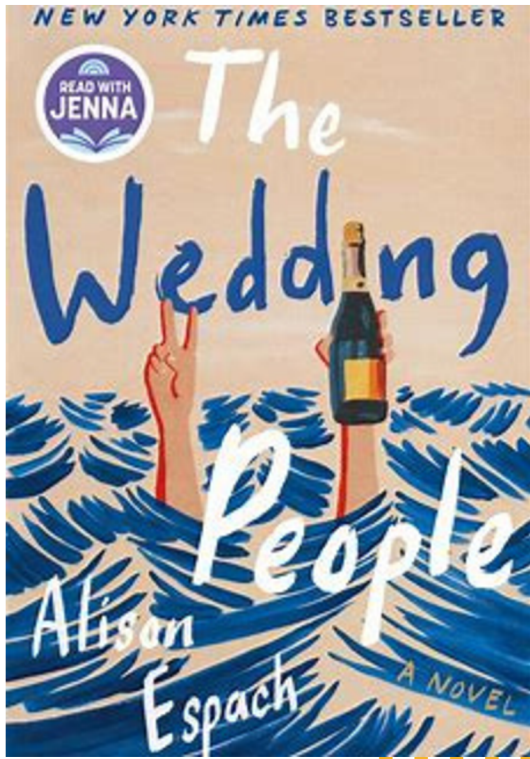
Interest Groups

Mint Julep

Ingredients:

- **Ingredients**
- **8 mint leaves**
- **1/4 ounce simple syrup**
- **2 ounces bourbon**
- **Garnish: mint sprig**
- **Garnish: Angostura bitters (optional)**

INSTRUCTIONS:

IN A JULEP CUP OR ROCKS GLASS, LIGHTLY MUDDLE THE MINT LEAVES IN THE SIMPLE SYRUP. ADD THE BOURBON THEN PACK THE GLASS TIGHTLY WITH CRUSHED ICE. STIR UNTIL THE CUP IS FROSTED ON THE OUTSIDE. TOP WITH MORE CRUSHED ICE TO FORM AN ICE DOME, GARNISH WITH MINT SPRIG AND A FEW DROPS OF BITTERS (OPTIONAL).



Mint Julep & Kentucky Derby....Did you Know???

The Mint Julep is a bourbon cocktail best known for being the signature drink of the Kentucky Derby.

The Mint Julep became the official drink of the Kentucky Derby in the 1930s, evolving from an 18th-century southern medicinal cocktail into a symbol of southern hospitality and Derby tradition.

The Mint Julep's connection to horse racing dates back to the early 1800s, when winners of races were sometimes awarded sterling silver julep cups. Its official status at the Kentucky Derby began in the 1930s, when Churchill Downs started serving the cocktail in souvenir silver cups, first ordered in 1937. Today, over 125,000 Mint Juleps are served during the Kentucky Oaks and Derby weekend, using thousands of bottles of Kentucky bourbon, fresh mint, and tons of ice.
