Next time you're at Twin Isles, stop by the Admin Office and let Kim know how much she's appreciated. She brings heart, humor, and dedication to our community every single day.

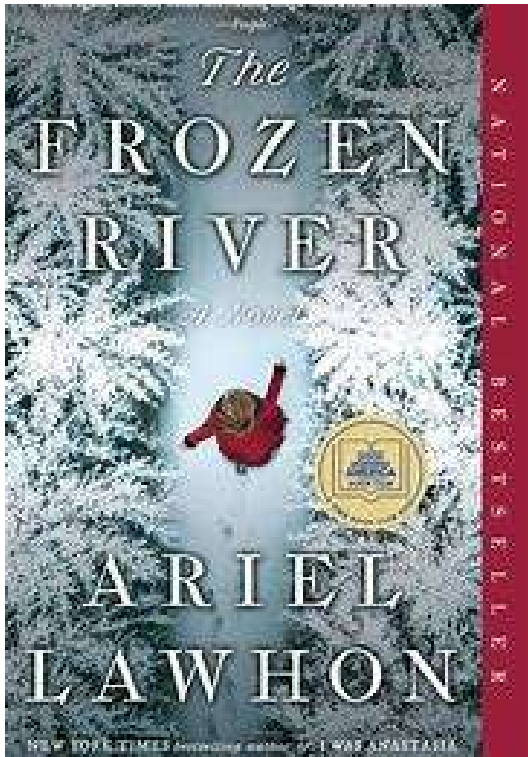
Interest Groups

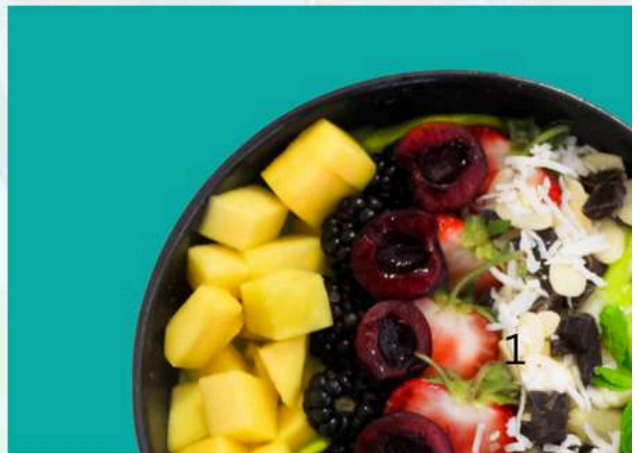

SUPERINTENDENT'S CORNER



Golf Maintenance is preparing for one of the most important agronomic periods of the year, and we'd like to share recent progress along with plans for early June.

As many of you are aware, SWFL has been under water restrictions that have contributed to some very dry areas on the course. We have been limited to watering our greens three times per week, fairways, tees, approaches and collars two times per week with no rough irrigation currently allowed. This has been a challenge for us and many other clubs in our region. Recently, the club added a new pump to our artesian well system to allow for more consistency and volume related to water flow into our irrigation pond that services the golf course. This has been on the list for several years and will ensure that we will continuously have water to irrigate the golf course, particularly during the drought season when water is at a premium.

On May 5th, we replaced the isolation irrigation valve servicing our 5-acre driving range floor. This area has been without irrigation for several years, but with the new valve now in place, we can isolate the range floor and begin repairing irrigation heads throughout which will allow us to begin to irrigate this area. This improvement will allow us to restore consistent irrigation coverage and bring the entire practice facility (including the driving range, putting green, chipping green, and tee line) to a healthier, greener, and more consistent conditions.

On May 12th, we applied a nematicide/fungicide treatment to all tee surfaces. This proactive treatment strengthens the turf ahead of aerification and prepares the tee tops to receive transplanted cores. It is an important cultural practice that supports turf recovery, disease prevention, and long-term playing quality.

From June 1-4, we will aerify all greens and tees. Aerification is a critical agronomic practice that reduces soil compaction, improves air and water movement, and promotes stronger, healthier root systems. Along with this process, we will transplant cores that we pull from the greens onto our tees. Our greens are planted with paspalum grass, and our long-term goal is to transition the tee tops to the same turf variety for improved consistency and performance throughout the golf course. With approximately 3 acres of greens and 3 acres of tees, we are able to repurpose the greens' core material to enhance the quality and accelerate this conversion process.

Looking Ahead

June will be a transformative month for course conditioning. Restoring irrigation to the range floor, strengthening tee surfaces and aerifying greens and key playing areas are all important steps toward delivering healthier turf conditions and an improved playing experience heading into the next season.
